## Feline ladder of aggression - progression of body language signs in response to perceived threat

- multiple bites grabbing with claws
- **1** Bite
- **Swat**
- **1** Stare
- **1** Ears turned back
- 1 Hiding
- right whole body hunched down , head down
- 1 Holding still, sitting still or grooming area touched)
- 1 Hair slightly raised over the back
- 1 Pupil s dilated
- **1** Ear flicking
- 1 Laying on sternum with legs tucked under body

These signs are common in examinations, shelter settings or where the cat cannot find a way to escape. A cat can progress as fast as .1 second through each step. Some cats will skip steps or suppress the body language as they escalate.
